

Volunteering for the SS Keewatin

The Y's Men welcomed former members Bill Prentice & Michael White to the October 1st, 2019 meeting. Bill was a member from 1979—2004 & a Past President in 1984. Bill started volunteering for the Keewatin just before it arrived in Port McNicoll several years ago. He's always had a keen interest in historical interpretation & he comes from a long line of mariners in his family. Built in 1907 in Glasgow Scotland, The SS Keewatin is the last of 3,800 Edwardian era ships built (like the Titanic) & the only 4 cylinder steam engine ship left in the world. It served as a passenger liner that once sailed between Port Arthur / Fort William on



Lake Superior and Port McNicoll on Georgian Bay in Ontario, Canada. She carried passengers between these ports for the Canadian Pacific Railway's Great Lakes steamship service. Bill takes visitors 2x per week from all over the world

on tours & really enjoys meeting all the people. The Friends of Keewatin are going to take over ownership & operation of the ship & application is being made to be a Class B museum. More volunteers are needed always! Thanks Bill for your service!

Estonia and Japan were also added to the list. Stavanger, Norway was the first Norwegian Club chartered on 22 November 1958.'
